-  **Observations:** Have you compared old photographs of polar regions with more recent ones? What difference did you see? What might explain those differences?
-  **People:** Have you interviewed elders in your community to find out what the environment was like when they were your age?
-  **Research:** Contact one of the IPY Alaska Researchers and conduct an interview to be posted on the Polar Power.

Exceptional entries will be invited to present their work at the 2008 Alaska Science Fair, March 21-23, 2008 in Anchorage, Alaska.
